

# Steeked Mug Cozy

**Sizes:** one size

**Version:** Plain(Simple, Advanced)

**Yarn:** Any 100% NON-superwash wool in a DK weight in 1 or 2 colors, <1oz of each.

**Needles:** US 6 or size to obtain gauge.

**Other Materials:** Sharp scissors, 2 stitch markers and depending upon the type of steek you wish to do:

Sewn Steek: Thread and sewing needle.

Crochet Steek: hook and small amount of wool in a lighter weight.

**Gauge:** 7sts = 1" in colorwork. (~5.5sts/1" in Stockinet Stitch)Take time to save time and check your gauge.

**Cozy:** CO 55(57, 55)sts in Color A. Join for working in the rnd being careful not to twist.

K2, PM, k2, (p1,k1) to last 3 sts, PM (beg rnd), k3.

Keeping the 5sts between markers in Stockinet Stitch, work ribbing for 1/2" ending at beg of rnd marker.

If working Plain, change to Stockinet Stitch and continue knitting in the rnd for 3".

For colorwork, add Color B now.

Work between the markers as follows: A, B, A, B, A.

Follow chart for colorwork pattern.

Work until piece meas 3".

knit 1 rnd in A.

Work 1/2" of ribbing.

BO all sts.
